Week 1 Our RMA Community

June 15 - June 19

Toddlers explore belonging through simple group activities, songs, practical life activities, and caring for their classroom and the wider community. This week focuses on social connections, taking turns, and learning that school is a safe, loving place.

Week 2 Nature As Our Classroom

June 22 - June 26

Campers will experience nature through sensory play, exciting outdoor activities, and discovery. We will touch, observe, and move in the fresh air while enjoying the outdoors.

Week 3 Stars, Stripes & Summer

June 29 - July 2

Campers will enjoy red, white, and blue sensory activities, music, and simple celebrations. We will explore colors, movement, 4th of July-themed works and joyful summer traditions.

Week 4 Ocean Explorers

July 6 - July 10

Toddlers will discover ocean animals through sensory bins, water play, and simple matching activities. This week builds early language, curiosity, and fine-motor skills while exploring the wonders of the sea.

Week 5 RMA Art Studio

July 13 - July 17

Campers will explore colors, textures, and materials through open-ended art experiences. This week focuses on creativity, fine-motor development, and joyful self-expression.

Week 6 The Montessori Kitchen

July 20 - July 24

Campers practice pouring, mixing, and preparing simple snacks while learning early independence. This week supports fine-motor skills, language, and confidence through safe, hands-on kitchen activities.

Week 7 Peace and Harmony

July 27 - July 31

Toddlers will explore kindness through gentle movement, simple yoga, calming moments, and caring activities. Campers will practice sharing, helping, and using their bodies and voices to create a peaceful classroom and wider world.

Week 8 Junior Engineers

August 3 - August 7

Children will build, stack, and explore simple cause-and-effect through blocks and hands-on STEM materials. This week supports problem-solving, coordination, and curiosity.

Week 9 The Wisconsin Fair

August 10 - August 14

Toddlers will enjoy farm animals, simple games, and fair-themed sensory play. This week introduces children to local traditions in a joyful and age-appropriate way!

Week 10 Montessori Workshop

August 17 - August 21

Campers will use simple tools, building materials, and hands-on activities to create and explore DIY projects. This week builds independence, coordination, and confidence through purposeful work.

Preschool Summer Camp

Introduction

Perfect for campers who are completely potty trained and have yet to attend Kindergarten. Campers benefit from an afternoon quiet period. Your 3 to 5-year-old will enjoy a multi-age summer camp classroom with activities geared toward your child's development. Alongside their camp teachers, campers will explore a different theme each week. Preschool field trip permission slips and any applicable fees will be communicated prior to the event.

Week 1 Our RMA Community

June 15 - June 19

Children practice Grace and Courtesy, cooperation, and friendship as they explore what it means to be part of a community. We will care for our classroom, help one another, and build respect through everyday Montessori interactions.

Week 2 Nature As Our Classroom

June 22 - June 26

Preschoolers will explore the natural world through hands-on outdoor work, nature observation, and imaginative camping play. Campers will build curiosity, respect for nature, and confidence as they learn outside the classroom.

Week 3 Stars, Stripes & Summer

June 29 - July 2

Children will learn about American symbols and celebrations through art, music, and hands-on projects. This week builds cultural awareness while celebrating summer fun and togetherness.

Week 4 Ocean Explorers

July 6 - July 10

Preschoolers will learn about ocean life, habitats, and conservation through hands-on activities, art, and science exploration. Children will build knowledge while developing a respect for the natural world.

Week 1 Our RMA Community

June 15 - June 19

Kindergarteners explore leadership, responsibility, and teamwork as they learn how communities function. Students will take on classroom roles, solve problems together, and reflect on how their choices contribute to a strong, respectful school community.

Week 2 Nature As Our Classroom

June 22 - June 26

Campers will study nature through science, exploration, and outdoor problem-solving. From plant and animal life to weather and habitats, children will deepen their understanding of the environment while enjoying outdoor learning.

Week 3 Stars, Stripes & Summer

June 29 - July 2

Campers will explore American history, symbols, and traditions through creative projects and discussions. We will connect our celebration to ideas of community, freedom, and responsibility.

Week 4 Ocean Explorers

July 6 - July 10

Children will dive deeper into marine biology, ecosystems, and ocean science. Through experiments and hands-on projects, students will explore how oceans support life and why protecting them matters.

Week 5 RMA Art Studio

Week 6 The Montessori Kitchen

July 20 - July 24

Campers will plan, prepare, and create recipes while learning about nutrition, measurement, and kitchen safety. This week blends real-world life skills with math, science, and responsibility.

Week 7 Peace and Harmony

July 27 - July 31

Children become thoughtful global citizens through mindfulness, yoga, and conflict-resolution activities. Campers engage in kindness projects and meaningful discussions that build empathy, self-control, and responsibility for caring for others and our world.

Week 8 Junior Engineers

August 3 - August 7

Kindergarteners will explore engineering, STEM challenges, and scientific thinking. Students will design, test, and improve their creations while practicing teamwork and problem-solving.

August 10 - August 14

Children will learn about Wisconsin agriculture, animals, and traditions. Through various projects and games, students will explore how farms, fairs, and food connect to our community.

August 17 - August 21

Campers will complete multi-step DIY projects using real tools and materials. This week focuses on craftsmanship, responsibility, and creative thinking through meaningful hands-on work.
