Developmental Area	Kindergarten (5 years by 9/1)
Independence & Self-Care	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consistently manages all personal needs• Demonstrates responsibility for belongings• Moves purposefully and gracefully in the environment• Models independence for younger peers
Language & Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Communicates ideas fluently and respectfully• Reads phonetically and writes simple words or sentences• Uses language to explore, reason, and collaborate
Social & Emotional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shows empathy, leadership, and emotional awareness• Manages emotions with minimal guidance• Contributes to a peaceful classroom community• Models grace and courtesy

Cognitive & Academic Growth	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Works independently for extended periods• Understands quantity, operations, and early place value• Reads and writes at an emerging primary level• Applies logical reasoning and creative problem-solving
Motor Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demonstrates precision and control in writing and tool use• Enjoys purposeful movement, outdoor play, and physical confidence
Attention & Concentration	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maintains concentration for full work cycles• Chooses, completes, and returns work independently• Finds joy in deep, uninterrupted work
